- 2. Personal Appearance of either parent or legal guardian
- 3. Original and photocopy of passport data page of either parent or legal
- Original and photocopy of court decision or order granting legal guardianship of the minor, if applicable

II. For RENEWAL OF PASSPORT

A. Standard Requirements:

- 1. Personal appearance of applicant
- Duly accomplished passport application form
 Valid passport and photocopy of passport data page
- Original and photocopy of Permesso di Soggiorno or Carta d'Identita
- Payment of Passport Application Fee of €54.00

B. Additional Requirements:

1. If applicant is a minor (below 18 years old):

- a. Personal appearance of either parent
- b. Original and photocopy of passport data page of either parent
- 2. For a married woman who would like to use the surname of her
 - Original and photocopy of Marriage Contract issued by the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA)
 If PSA Marriage Contract is blurred or unreadable:
 original and photocopy of Marriage Contract issued
 - by the Local Civil Registrar
 b. Original and photocopy of the Report of Marriage

3. For a married woman who would like to revert to her maiden name:

 - Other documents showing photo and signature of applicant, as may be required, such as any of the following:
 - Voter's ID, Professional Regulation Commission (PRC), Driver's License, Seaman's Book, Transcript of Records, Diploma, Government Service Record, Social Security System (SSS) ID, Government Service Insurance System (GSIS) ID

IV. EXTENSION OF VALIDITY OF PASSPORT

A holder of a valid e-passport may apply for an extension of the period of its validity only under the following conditions

- 1. Death in the family requiring the Filipino national or any of his/her dependent family members to urgently travel to the Philippines
- 2. Medical or legal emergency requiring the Filipino nationals or his/her dependents to urgently travel to the Philippines or any other country for medical treatment or legal proceedings
- 3. Compliance with the following
 - a. An application for renewal of e-passport has to be filed simultaneously with the application for extension of passport validity
 - b. Applicant may present proof of urgency, such as death certificate, medical certificate and similar medical documents, subpoena or notices of hearing and the like. Confirmed flight details and plane tickets may also be presented.
 - c. E-passport validity extension may only be given to expiring passports. Expired passports shall not be allowed for validity extension.

- d. Machine-Ready Readable Passports (MRRPs) or Machine-Readable Passport (MRPs) cannot be extended or revalidated.
- e. The extended passport shall be cancelled immediately upon applicant's receipt of the new (renewed) passport. In no case shall extended
- f. The extension facility shall be available only under the conditions stated above and cannot be made available for applicants intending to travel only for tourism purposes.

V. TRAVEL DOCUMENT

A Filipino citizen who does not have a valid passport, for one reason or another, and wishes to return to the Philippines, may apply for a Travel Document in lieu of a passport for his/her direct return to the Philippines. Applicant has to undergo interview by a consular officer and comply with the following documentary

- Duly accomplished Travel Document application form
- Copy of Police Report or Denuncia for lost passport
- 3. Affidavit of Loss/ Explanation
- Photocopy of lost Philippine passport or Birth Certificate issued by the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA)

 5. Interview with Assistance-to-Nationals (ATN) Officer
- 6. Three (3) pieces of ID photo (size 4.5 cm. x 3.5 cm.) with white background
- Other documents as may be required
- 8. Payment of Travel Document fee of €27.00

IMPORTANT:

- A Travel Document is issued ONLY for the purpose of direct travel to the Philippines
- For a convenient travel to the Philippines, applicant is strongly recommended to consult an ATN Officer at the Embassy before booking flight arrangements.
